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Synopsis

Urbanization is evolving at an unprecedented speed in Asia, and this has led us to develop infrastructure deeper underground in a denser urban setting more than ever. MRT, underground road tunnels, deep sewage tunnels, underground storage tanks and even sewage treatment plants are being relocated to underground, in order to free up precious land in the city area. To achieve this, deep excavation is inevitable. So, how do we carry out deep excavation in a safe and controlled manner? What are the considerations in the deep excavation and ERSS design? This talk will introduce the common ERSS techniques, and major considerations in the scheme development and specific ERSS designs. Several interesting case experiences of ERSS design in both Hong Kong/Singapore will also be shared accordingly in this webinar.
