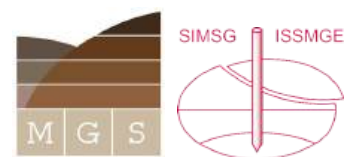

CLAUSE 8 COMMITTEE

Existing Statute: -

- 8.1 A committee consisting of the following, who shall be termed the office-bearers of the Society, shall be elected at the annual general meeting: -
- a. President
 - b. Deputy President
 - c. Secretary General
 - d. Honorary Treasurer
 - e. 4 Ordinary Elected Committee Members
 - f. Immediate Past President

In addition, the Committee may co-opt up to five (5) additional members of the Society to attend (generally for a period of one year). Selection shall be by majority vote. These Co-opted members shall have no voting rights at Committee meetings.

Proposed Revision: -

- 8.1 *A committee consisting of the following, who shall be termed the office-bearers of the Society, shall be elected at the annual general meeting: -*
- a. *President*
 - b. *Deputy President*
 - c. *Secretary General*
 - d. *Honorary Treasurer*
 - e. *Up to 6 Ordinary Elected Committee Members*
 - f. *Immediate Past President*

*In addition, the Committee may co-opt up to **ten (10)** additional members of the Society to attend (generally for a period of one year). Selection shall be by majority vote. These Co-opted members shall have no voting rights at Committee meetings.*

Reason of Changes: -

As the Society is growing bigger and getting more active locally as well as in the international scene, there is a need for more committee members to serve and contribute to the Society.
