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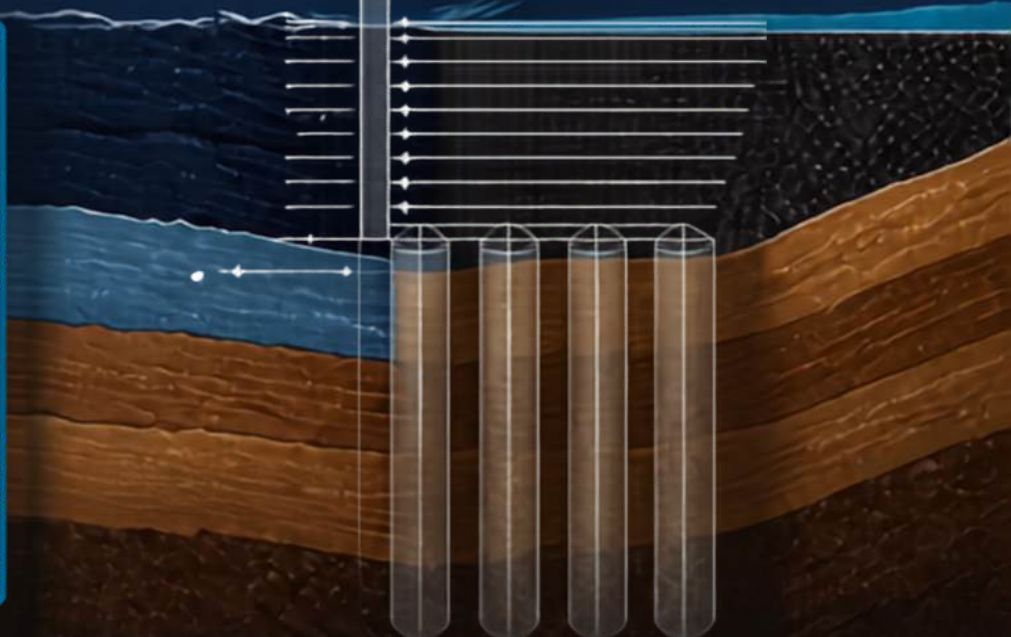

Webinar on Ground Improvement with Deep Soil Mixing (DSM), case study of DSM to support reinforced soil wall

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SYNOPSIS

With the increasing demand for safer, more cost-effective, and sustainable solutions in the construction industry, geotechnical engineers are often required to develop innovative approaches to challenging ground conditions. Ground improvement can provide an effective solution to such geotechnical challenges, with the selection of the appropriate technique being dependent on factors such as ground conditions, design requirements, construction constraints, and project objectives.

This presentation will introduce the key considerations in selecting a suitable ground improvement technique, with a particular focus on Deep Soil Mixing (DSM). The principles of DSM, key design considerations, and factors influencing its applicability will be discussed. A case study involving the application of DSM to support a Reinforced Earth wall will also be presented, highlighting the design approach and practical considerations in implementing DSM.

The presentation will conclude with a sharing session on the speaker's participation in the 8th International Young Geotechnical Engineers Conference in Graz, Austria, which was sponsored by the Malaysian Geotechnical Society (MGS).
